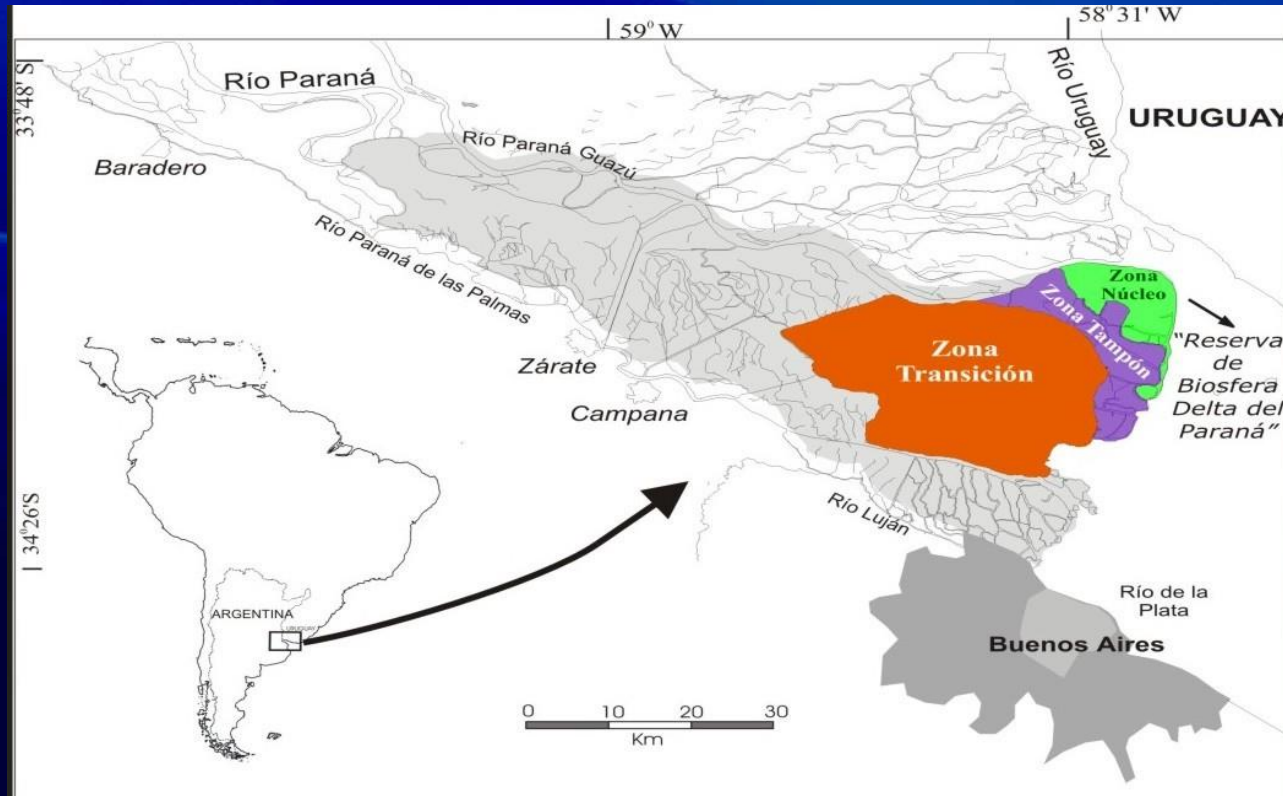

Development of basic research on relictual native forests and secondary forests.



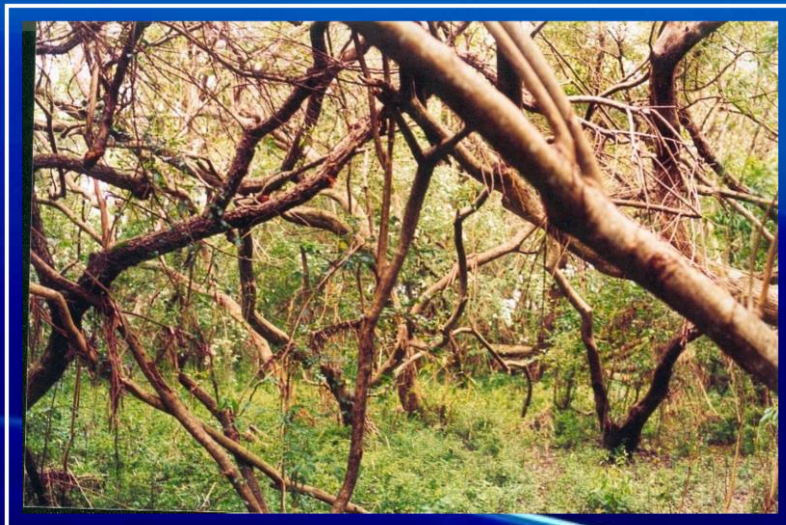
B- Development an “Environmental Education Program” in the BRPDelta.



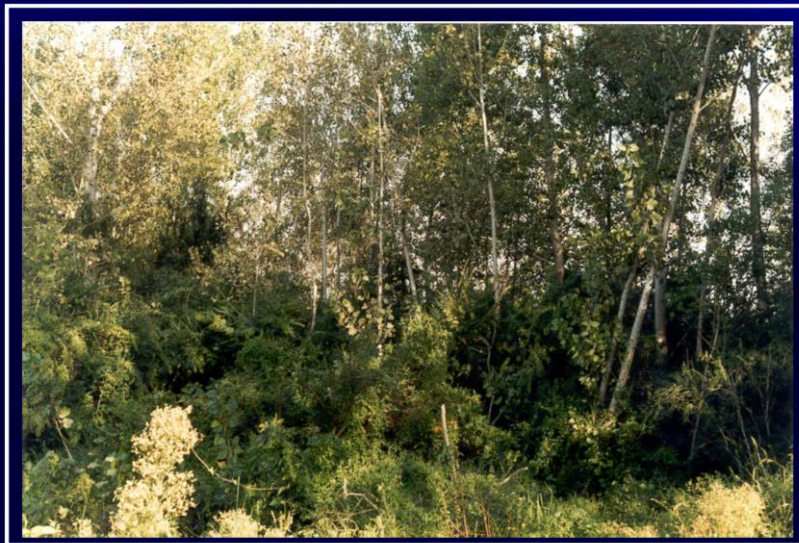

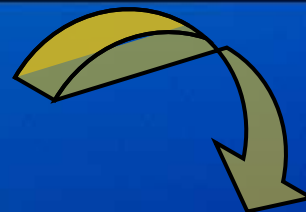

Native Forest: *Monte Blanco*



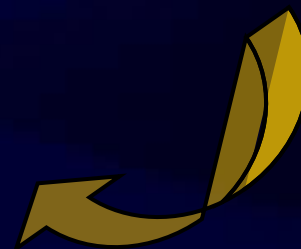
