


Carpathian Heritage of Ukraine: competitive advantage of green development





Vision for Carpathians





In the Green Heart of Europe the people value nature and take action to preserve natural treasures both within and outside of the region.





Current trend:

- Enlargement PA network and development of ecological network;
- Deterioration of protected areas due to territory war and occupation (lost control over PAs and ecological network);
- Greater involvement of the civic sector in PA management (ForestWatch);
- Ukraine-EU Association Agreement;
- Insufficient capacity and poor funding for PAs;
- Insufficient cooperation with local authorities and communities;
- High demand for tourism development (infrustructure projects);
- Illegal logging and illegal timber trade (corruption).



Goal: To ensure that is most critical areas for biodiversity conservation in the Eastern Carpathians, critical gaps and ecological network → higher degree of connectivity


Regional Gap Analysis Illustrates threats for biodiversity hotspots


Potential up to 50% increase for National and Landscape parks

Virgin and Old Growth Forests of the Ukraine Carpathians - Outstanding World Heritage




